



DRESS CODE RULES

Students must abide by all dress code rules by wearing:

- **Collared Polo shirt**
- **Dress pants (*No Jeans*)**
- **Sneakers or soft sole shoes**
- **Belt**

1. Upon entrance, shirts must be securely tucked into pants and remain tucked throughout the day.
2. Shirts and tops must be of plain design (i.e. company logo). Clothing with crude, poorly worded, suggestive language or suggestive pictures is not permitted. No clothing may have alcohol, tobacco, drug labels or symbols written or printed on them. No clothing may have pictures or rebel flag or “Malcom X” or other racially insensitive references. No hooded shirts are permitted past check-in point.
3. Shirts/blouses must reach below the top of the pants at all time. No cleavage showing at any time.
4. Pants must be worn at the waistline. *Pants must have belt loops*, (see experimental new policy) belts must be worn at all times in correct notch. *No large attached belt buckles*. No cargo pants with big pockets or clothing made of spandex or stretch material (i.e. no athletic or biker shorts, sweat pants, leggings, dresses or skirts).
5. Pants may not be excessively baggy or touching the floor. The principal’s definition of sagging is: when someone’s trousers fall below the band of his or her underwear. You are considered sagging even if your shirt covers the area. A person’s weight will be taken into consideration by the principal.
6. No clothing with holes will be permitted.
7. Sneakers or soft sole shoes ONLY, no sandals, flip-flops, house shoes or boots will be permitted *Sneakers must be laced, tied or tucked upon entrance and remain tied throughout the day.*
8. Jackets may be worn into the building but may not be worn during the school day. Jackets must be hung on coat rack upon entrance. Students may wear long sleeves under shirt.
9. No hats, caps, bandannas or other head coverings are permitted as clothing or hair accessory.
10. Hair must be kept neat, clean and out of face. Hair may not distract the learning environment.
11. No jewelry of any sort shall be worn while attending TRLC. Jewelry must be left at home. *Even small plastic post for nose or ears will not be permitted.* (see experimental new policy).
