

RESTRICTED LUNCH RULES

- 1. Each student entering the TRLC is assigned 20 days restricted lunch.
- 2. Restricted lunch will be separate from general lunch population.
- 3. *No talking or noise* is allowed for duration of the period.
- 4. Students may quietly work on uncompleted assignments after finishing lunch.
- 5. Excessive unexcused tardies may result in additional day restricted lunch.
- 6. Students suspended or referred to court by TRLC will return to restricted lunch (principal discretion).
- 7. Refusal to comply with restricted lunch rules can result in additional restricted lunch.
- 8. Students who refuse to comply with TRLC Dress Code Rules will serve additional restricted lunch.

How Can I earn my way into a regular lunch privilege?

- Complete 20 days' evaluation period
- Have acceptable behavior and attendance
- Satisfactory grades no grades below a "D" on mid-term or final grade card
- No suspensions, referrals to court from TRLC
- Minimal write-ups no more than five in a nine-week period
- Total compliance with restricted lunch rules
- Absences and tardies must be within the acceptable limits according to Cocke County School Board policies

REGULAR LUNCH RULES

After entering into regular lunch all rules are determined by teacher's discretion; refusal to comply with each individual teacher's rules additional time in restricted lunch classification may be assigned.

- Students may talk quietly unless otherwise requested by teacher to remain silent
- Seats may be assigned at teacher's discretion
- Students remain seated at teacher's discretion
- Only one student at a time is allowed out of lunch room
- Students must select all lunch items before entering into assigned lunch room
